

# University Student Subsidy Scheme

## Terms and Conditions

1. Applicants may apply from any country worldwide.
2. Successful applicants must provide one form of evidence to support their application. Depending on student status (prospective or current) this may be:
  - a. An acceptance letter from your University.
  - b. Photograph/scan of your student ID, matriculation card or similar. (Sensitive information such as student number etc may be hidden, but this evidence must show both **your name** and the **name of your University**.)
3. Applicants may either visit the Classical Guitar Academy studio to choose their instrument or choose to purchase online.
4. Successful applicants will receive a document via email with details of guitars eligible for the student subsidy scheme, along with the subsidised price of each instrument.
  - a. Prices are for the guitar and case only.
  - b. The cost of shipping will be calculated separately.
5. Successful applicants must book a retail appointment before visiting the studio.
6. Successful applicants may request a virtual retail appointment if they would like help selecting a guitar when purchasing online.
7. All purchases may be returned within 14 days for any reason in line with our 'Refund Policy'.
8. Classical Guitar Academy reserves the right to discontinue, change or postpone this scheme without prior notice.
9. Classical Guitar Academy reserves the right to refuse an applicant's acceptance onto the scheme at it's discretion.
